The APWA GA Chapter Internship Program offers hands-on internship experiences to undergraduate college students interested in considering a public works and/or engineering career in city/county government. For the summer of 2019, the APWA GA Chapter has approved funding in the amount of \$10,000 to support four internships with a matching grant of \$2500 each to APWA Member local governments that are selected to participate in the program. A typical intern work period is 40 hours per week for 10-12 weeks at an average pay of \$15/hour (total cost for one intern is approximately \$5,000 to \$6000).

The matching grant funds for this program will be awarded on a first come ó first serve basis. Interns may be recruited and selected independently by the local government or may be selected from resumes submitted to and provided by the APWA GA Chapter. At the conclusion of the internship, grant recipients will be required to provide a summary (and photographs) of the work performed by the intern.
