It is with great disappointment that we must announce that the APWA Georgia Chapter 2020 Annual Meeting and CPWM Training scheduled for July 7-10, 2020 has been canceled.

The Administration Board of the Georgia Chapter over the past months held multiple teleconference meetings with our partners at University of Georgia, Carl Vinson Institute of Government to consider all options and collect as much data and information as it could to make a recommendation to the Executive Board during these trying times.

The Georgia Chapter APWA Executive Board held a teleconference meeting on May 20, 2020, after very careful consideration, the Board unanimously decided to postpone/cancel the Annual Meeting and the CPWM Training that was to be held concurrent with the Annual Meeting.

Ultimately, the decision came down to considering your health and safety and the current financial impacts on our local governments. While we believe that our Annual Meeting is a great investment in the education of our members, no conference is worth putting people at potential health risk

In order to ensure our APWA's members continue to have access to our CPWM training, the Executive Board of the Georgia Chapter has directed our partners at Carl Vinson Institute of Government to create an online CPWM training to take place later this summer. Currently we are hoping to hold the training online sometime in August. More information about the new virtual event will be made available in the upcoming weeks.
